Lambton County Businesses and Organizations,

As always, information continues to rapidly change and, therefore, we are forwarding you another letter to ensure your business is aware of some updates to processes that may impact your business.

Enhanced Proof of Vaccination

It is now mandatory to use the enhanced vaccine certificate with the QR code to gain access to settings that require proof of vaccination. There are two exclusions that include community members of the First Nations and Visitors from Outside of Canada (reference page 8/9 for more details). Businesses and organizations are required to verify the enhanced vaccine certificate using the Verify Ontario app.

Updated Screening Tools

Active screening of employees and patrons of certain businesses continues to be a mandatory requirement to implement. Recent updates (January 31, 2022) have been made to reflect the changes to the <u>Provincial Case and Contact Management Guidance</u> (January 14, 2022).
